DAY 1 CONCEPT IDEATION

Industry technical experts share what technology is currently available and how it can solve DoD and Joint community problems.

DAY 3 SOLUTION GENERATION

Break into smaller groups by interest or operational area to form a short and relevant problem statement, then ideate on how we might use CSfC to impact each problem statement.
